AGENDA POINT-1

CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE LAST AGM HELD IN RANCHI:

The minutes of the last Annual General Meeting (AGM) that was held at R K Anand Bowls Green, Namkum, Ranchi 2023 was confirmed. The minutes of this meeting were meticulously reviewed and discussed during the meeting held.

During the meeting, the members present had the opportunity to thoroughly examine the minutes of the previous AGM. After careful consideration and deliberation the same was Proposed by Sri Harbhajan Singh and seconded by Sri Suresh Kumar Singh.

AGENDA POINT -2

CONFIRMATION OF THE SECRETARY REPORT:

The Secretary's Annual Report was presented before the members for their review and consideration. The report encompassed a comprehensive overview of the association's activities and achievements during the past year.

Following a thorough examination and open discussion of the report, the members present reached a unanimous decision to pass and approve the Secretary's Annual Report.

Mr. S K Pandey proposed the approval of the report which was seconded by Sri Manoj Kumar Yadav.

AGENDA POINT -3

PASSING OF THE AUDITED ACCOUNTS FOR THE SESSION 2023-24:

The audited balance sheet for the stated session was formally presented before the members for their review and consideration. The document provided a comprehensive overview of the financial transactions and activities undertaken by the association during the specified period.

During the presentation, Mr. Pathak, the Secretary-General, informed the attendees about the financial aspects related to the receipt and utilization of funds. Mr. Pathak informed the members that no funds were allotted to the JOA from the state government. He also informed that the association is still waiting to receive the TA and DA for the state team and funds for the coaching camp.

After a thorough discussion and assessment of the presented information, the members collectively approved the financial transactions as documented in the audited balance sheet. Mr. Ritesh Jha formally proposed the approval, while Ajay Jha seconded the proposal.

AGENDA POINT -4

DISCUSSION ON THE ORGANIZATION OF STATE GAMES:

A brief discussion was held on the conduct of the State Games. All members felt that the Jharkhand Olympic Association should organize the State Games regularly to provide a platform for state players. It was decided to constitute a five-member committee to finalize the modalities for the State Games.

The following members were nominated for the **STATE GAMES COMMITTEE**: Suresh Kumar, Sanjay Sharma, Ashish Kumar Jha, Varun Kumar, and Manoj Kumar Yadav. The proposal was made by Dr. Nishikant and seconded by Sri Gulam Rabbani.

It was also decided that in any committee, the President, Secretary, and Treasurer will be common members.

The following suggestions were received from the members: -

Members suggested proposing financial assistance from the Department of Sports. Additionally, it was suggested that if there is no support from the government, the concerned state association will organize the event and bear all expenses, while the JOA will provide medals and certificates only. Furthermore, the branding design will be provided by the JOA only. It was decided to organize the same in the month of September 2024

The proposal for the above was made by Dr. Nishikant and seconded by Sri Gulam Rabbani.

AGENDA POINT -5

ARRANGEMENTS FOR SEMINAR ON ANTI DOPING, SPORTS INJURY, PHYSIOTHERAPY AND CHILD PSYCHOLOGY FOR THE COACHES:

To enhance the awareness of coaches and players about scientific training methods, it has been decided that the JOA will organize a seminar on Sports Injury and Physiotherapy. Expert speakers from reputed institutes will be invited to share their knowledge.

Additionally, the JOA will be contacted to coordinate an Anti-Doping seminar in collaboration with NADA (National Anti-Doping Agency). This seminar will aim to educate participants about the importance of fair play and the consequences of doping in sports.

The seminar is scheduled to take place at the R K Anand Bowls Green, with a nominal registration fee to cover expenses.

The agenda was proposed by Sri Chanchal Bhattacharya and seconded by Sri Archit Anand.

AGENDA POINT -6

PREPARATION AND PARTICIPATION OF STATE TEAM IN 38TH NATIONAL GAMES:

Dr. Mahukant Pathak informed the members that the 38th National Games are scheduled to take place during February 2025. He confirmed that the Jharkhand team will participate in the games according to their qualification and quota. He emphasized that all state associations must strive to secure their positions through qualification in the National Games.

The agenda was proposed by Sri S.K. Pandey and seconded by Sri N.K. Dey.

AGENDA POINT -7

AMENDMENT OF CONSTITUTION OF JOA.

It has been resolved to amend the JOA constitution to align it with the IOA constitution and the sports code. The responsibility to form the Constitution Amendment Committee has been entrusted to the President of JOA.

The committee will oversee various matters related to the amendment process and seek approval from the Executive Committee (EC) and General Body in due course. Furthermore, it has been decided that every State Sports Association affiliated with JOA must submit its annual report, which should include the previous year's annual report, audit report, list of office bearers, and annual calendar.

These reports will subsequently be forwarded to the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) for further review and action.

The agenda was proposed by Sri Gulam Rabbani and seconded by Sri Khurshid Khan.

AGENDA POINT -8

FORMATION OF DIFFERENT COMMITTEE EG CONSTITUTION AMENDMENT COMMITTEE, AFFILIATION COMMITTEE.

It was resolved to establish an Affiliation Committee and other sub-committees to facilitate the normal functioning of JOA. Dr. Pathak suggested that JOA should grant affiliation to all sports associations that are part of the National Games in recognized categories. It was decided that in instances where federations grant affiliation to new bodies, JOA should stand by the association already affiliated with it. Previously, JOA supported Handball, Basketball, and Taekwondo, even when federations granted affiliation to other bodies, demonstrating loyalty to its affiliated entities.

Suresh Kumar proposed that the process of providing affiliation to any such application should not exceed 30 days. Dr. Pathak emphasized that it is not conducive for federations to attempt to change district bodies arbitrarily. Establishing a district unit within a sports association requires significant effort, and therefore, there should be no allowance for changes without proper consideration. He suggested that JOA maintain a comprehensive list of office bearers from district associations to ensure transparency and accountability in the process.

This agenda was proposed by Ashish Kumar and seconded by C D Singh.

AGENDA POINT -9

DISCUSSION ON IMPLEMENTATION OF SPORTS POLICY

Dr. Madhukant Pathak briefed the members about a letter sent to the State Government, including the Chief Minister, Minister of Sports, Secretary of Sports, and Director of Sports, highlighting the need for the proper implementation of the State Sports Policy. He emphasized that despite the existence of the policy, its provisions have not been effectively put into practice. Dr. Pathak underscored the importance of categorizing sporting events annually and addressing discrepancies in cash awards and other related matters.

Sri Shekhar Bose proposed that a delegation from JOA should meet with the Chief Minister of Jharkhand and other relevant officials to address the issue. He mentioned a recent letter from the sports directorate to the District Sports Officers (DSOs) regarding the implementation of a new policy on state and district sports associations, which was met with resistance. He suggested that state and district associations should consider boycotting government initiatives in response.

Gulam Rabbani pointed out that the implementation of the sports code is not the responsibility of the state government.

He emphasized that state associations are obligated to adhere to the rules and guidelines set forth by the concerned federations. So, finally it was decided that a committee should meet the Govt. officials for implementation of the sports policy.

This agenda was proposed by Samarjeet Singh and seconded by George Lakra.

ANY OTHER MATTER WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR

- 1. Mr. Shivendra Dubey brought to the attention of the members that the affiliation fees of various associations are outstanding from previous years. It was unanimously decided that all District Olympic Associations (DOAs) and State Sports Associations (SSAs) should ensure timely payment of their affiliation fees to JOA on or before 31st December every year as per constitution. As per request of few members three months grace period will be given. Failure to do so will be dealt as per the decision taken during last AGM held on 11th August 2023 which was unanimously accepted by the house.
- 2. Dr. Madhukant Pathak proposed that, to promote various sports in Jharkhand, JOA should grant affiliation to all sports associations that are part of the National Games. Affiliation should be granted in the recognized category. The status of affiliated units will be bestowed upon those sports associations only that participate in the Olympics, Asian Games, and Commonwealth Games.
- 3. It was decided that in the event of a dispute created by a Federation at the state level through the changing of an association, JOA will support the committee that received affiliation from JOA, not the new committee. All member units of JOA are required to adhere to the rules and regulations of JOA and their respective federations exclusively.
- 4. Dr. Madhukant Pathak informed the members that during the last meeting, it was decided to establish a club at the R K Anand Bowls Green, which was approved by the members. He suggested that, in addition, there could be a Bowls Academy to properly train players, as the stadium had been handed over to the Jharkhand Bowling Association for the specific purpose of training lawn bowls players. He also proposed that the clubhouse and other open areas could be utilized for marriages and other ceremonies to generate funds, which could then be used for the maintenance of the entire premises. This would create a fund, with income generated from these activities being divided fifty percent each between the Jharkhand Bowling Association and the Jharkhand Olympic Association.
- 5. Sri Sanjay Sharma stated that this is the need of the hour, and all member units must unite to raise their voice to fight with the Department of Sports to press their demands, which were accepted by the house.
- 6. Mr. Manoj Kumar Yadav emphasized, in accordance with the Olympic Charter, that governmental interference should be avoided in Olympic matters.
- 7. It was decided that each State Sports Association (SSA) should obtain registration and provide their district-wise details to the Jharkhand Olympic Association.
- 8. Sri S. K. Pandey suggested that members, particularly those from Ranchi, should make regular visits to the JOA office to engage in healthy discussions on sports promotion and other related matters which was gladly accepted by the members.
- 9. Mr. C Das suggested that all State Sports Associations should register all of their district associations with the District Olympic Association. Dr. Pathak suggested that the affiliation fee should be a maximum of Rs 500 only.
- 10. Sri Harbhajan Singh suggested that all State Sports Associations under the banner of the Jharkhand Olympic Association should convene a meeting with the Department of Sports.
- 11. Sri Sekhar Bose suggested reorganizing the JOA Awards, proposing the addition of awards for "Best Coach," "Player," "Association," etc., similar to the award categories recognized by the Government of India. A four-member committee was formed under the chairmanship of Sri Harbhajan Singh, with Mr. Gulam Rabbani and Asesh Jha as members, and Shivendra Dubey as the convenor to finalize the modalities of the awards. All members agreed that the awards should be presented regularly.

- 12. Mr. Deepak Agarwal from the Jharkhand Squash Association expressed willingness to sponsor as Title Sponsor of the JOA Award Ceremony annually. Dr. Pathak recommended that he should coordinate with Mr. Shivendra Dubey, the treasurer of JOA, to finalize all details.
- 13. Dr. Pathak informed the house about the RTI received from Dhanbad regarding the Tennis Association matter, and it was unanimously decided by all the members present to provide a proper reply to RTI.
- 14. Sri Ajay Jha suggested that the District Olympic Association should provide one more platform to players from their district by organizing the District Olympic Games on a regular basis.
- 15. Dr. Pathak informed the members about their support to the Education Department for the conduct of Khelo Jharkhand and the SGFI National events. He suggested that the JOA should enter into an MOU with the Department of Education for the promotion of sports at the school level and the organization of Khelo Jharkhand and SGFI championships. Additionally, they can utilize the infrastructure available with the Education Department for training or conducting sports championships.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair and other members by Sri Sekhar Bose.

Together, with unity and dedication, we aim to build a vibrant sports culture in Jharkhand and pave the way for more national and international successes.



Meeting with the Joint Secretary Sports, Govt. of India




